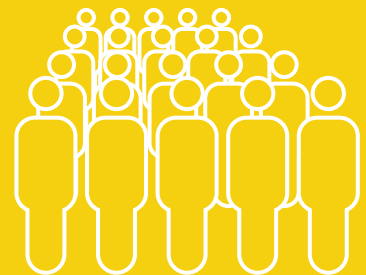

The company known today as Dynniq UK Ltd was founded in 1980 as GK Instruments Ltd, specialising in Traffic Detection and Classification projects.

**1989-1991**

Acquired by Peek PLC in 1989 and renamed Peek Traffic Ltd in 1991.



**1991**

Acquisition of Philips Traffic Control & Ferranti Road Traffic Systems adds urban traffic control systems using SCOOT and motorway control systems to the portfolio. Peek now #2 in the global traffic market.



**2007**

Imtech N.V. bought Peek Group

**1995**

Acquired GEC Marconi Transport Systems, bringing additional urban traffic control systems and installation and maintenance capability.

**1993**

The traffic signals installation and maintenance business of Elequip was acquired.



**2013**

Peek renamed and rebranded Imtech Traffic & Infra.

**2015**

Acquired by Dutch Private Equity company Egeria, August 2015.

**2016**

Imtech Traffic & Infra renamed and rebranded Dynniq. Dynniq harnesses technology to improve how people travel – safely, reliably and within a sustainable environment.
